Criteria for Graduation:

1. Earn GPA of **at least** 2.00, calculated from all EE courses excluding free electives and extra-curriculum courses.
2. Earn, **at least**, C in EE 311 or EE 312, otherwise regrading is necessary. If the grades from both courses are below C, select either of them to regrade. After regrading, select the one with better grade for GPA calculation.
