About Admissions to the B.E. International Program International Student Track

Faculty of Economics, Thammasat University

Academic Year 2026

Thammasat University, hereafter “The University”, has announced admissions requirements for the B.E. International Program of the Faculty of Economics, hereafter “The Program.” This announcement contains details regarding admissions requirements for the International Student Track, Academic year 2026.

1. Program Location

Thammasat University, Tha Prachan Campus

2. Applicant Qualifications

1. Applicants must be international students who hold a foreign passport, or Thai students possessing dual passports.
2. Thai applicants with dual passports can apply for only one track, either Thai or international, and are not permitted to apply to both tracks in the same round.
3. Applicants must have completed high school studies (or the equivalent) at an accredited school.
4. Applicants who have not yet fulfilled all requirements for a high school diploma must do so before entering the program.
5. Applicants must have a clean bill of health.
6. Applicants must be willing to follow the University code of conduct.

7. Applicants must not have been accused or sanctioned for admissions exam misconduct during the previous three years.
8. Applicants must not be enrolled in any other university or higher-level educational institution in Thailand.
9. Foreign applicants must legally reside in Thailand, and show legal proof of residence status before entering the program.

4. Application Requirements

4.1 Applicants must achieve the minimum score in one of the following:

Please note:

1. Official score reports of SAT/ TOEFL/ IELTS/TU-GET/ DUOLINGO ENGLISH TEST are valid only if taken less than two years before the B.E. application deadline.
2. Applicants may submit multiple score reports for mathematics and English for each subject.
3. Applicants may use SAT (Math) and SAT(EBRW) scores from different test dates.
4. The SAT code for the Thammasat B.E. program is 8003.
5. The code for reporting IELTS is Faculty of Economics, (B.E. International Program).
6. The code for reporting DUOLINGO ENGLISH TEST is B.E. Program, Thammasat University.

4.2 Interview

1. The interview is conducted in English.
2. Applicants must attend the interview at the arranged time. If an applicant does not report for an interview, that applicant will be disqualified.
3. The Admissions Committee will select applicants eligible for interview based on score rankings as mentioned in item 4.1.

5. Selection Criteria

1. The Admissions Committee will evaluate applicants based on scores, as mentioned in item 4.1, and the interview.
2. All Admissions Committee for Undergraduate Study decisions are final.

7. Application Procedure and Application Fee

7.1 Complete the application online on <https://admission.be.econ.tu.ac.th> before the specified deadline. Application forms must be accompanied by the following documents:

- A copy of the applicant's passport.
- One digital photograph (full-faced view directly facing the camera in student uniform or polite attire taken within the past six months. Do not wear a hat or sunglasses.)
- High school certification.
 - For applicants who graduated high school, a high school certificate and transcript are required.
 - For applicants currently enrolled in high school or the equivalent, a certificate of student status from the current institution is required.
- Certified copies of exam results as specified in item 4.1.
 - For SAT, please upload the downloaded report score (PDF file) from www.collegeboard.org on the B.E. online application system. The official SAT score report(s) must be sent directly to the B.E. Program. The SAT code is 8003.
 - For SAT/IELTS/TU-GET/TOEFL/DUOLINGO ENGLISH TEST, please scan and upload the report score(s) on the B.E. online application system. Official score report(s) must be sent directly to the B.E. Program.
 - The code for IELTS is Faculty of Economics, (B.E. International Program).
 - The code for the DUOLINGO ENGLISH TEST is Thammasat University, B.E. International Program.

- For TU-GET score report(s), the B.E. program will coordinate with the relevant testing center for the official score.
- For TOEFL score reports, applicants must send documents to the address of the B.E. Program.

Please note: Official of SAT/TOEFL/ IELTS/TU-GET/DUOLINGO ENGLISH TEST score reports must be sent to the B.E. Program before the interview date of each round.

7.2 Verify correctness and completeness of information in the application form. If information provided is incorrect or incomplete, please make necessary corrections. The university prioritizes information provided in the online application system.

7.3 The application fee is 1,000 Thai baht (transaction fees and surcharges not included). Payment can be made by printing the payment form and paying the application fee at the counter of any Bangkok Bank branch, as well as through the online mobile banking and internet banking systems. Applicants may check payment status at least three business days after payment at the B.E. online application system.

7.4 Incomplete applications will be dismissed with no refunds.

8. Tuition Fee

The rates for tuition are as stated in this announcement.
